

F-1 OPT Online Application Checklist

REMINDER: The OPT application must be received by USCIS <u>within 30 days</u> of the date on which ISSS issues an OPT I-20. If filed with USCIS after 30 days of the OPT I-20 issuance date, your application will be denied. Please contact your ISSS advisor to request OPT I-20 if yours is almost 30 days old and you have not submitted it yet.

To prepare the OPT online application for USCIS, assemble the following requirements:

- ✓ <u>I-765 Application Fee</u>
 - o the current fee is \$410; Please see https://www.uscis.gov/i-765 under Filing Fee.
 - o Note: there is NO biometric fee for OPT.

✓ US Passport-Style Photo

 Upload a clear color image of your face taken within the last six months. No selfies or photo filters. No glasses. White or off-white background only. Refer to the photo guidelines on <u>Department of State</u> website.

✓ Form I-765

- o Please refer to our filing guide for form I-765 for OPT at this link.
- USCIS provides tips for filing online on its website also.

✓ Digital copies of your documents:

can be in black and white or color. Must be in acceptable formats.

- New OPT I-20 (make sure to sign and date before you upload it)
- Passport Identification or biographical page(s)
- Most recent I-94 record, found at I94 Official Website: www.cbp.gov/i94
- o All previous EADs (if applicable), front and back
- All previous CPT and/or OPT authorized I-20s see https://global.upenn.edu/isss/f-1-opt-faqs if you are missing I-20s.
 - If you have Change of Education Level I-20s, submit previous degree's I-20 and Change of Education Level I-20 in addition to above.

Final Steps

- Check all documents for completeness and accuracy. Refer to the USCIS <u>I-765 Instructions</u> and the <u>ISSS Online Filing</u> Guide.
- 2. Finally, if you decide NOT to apply for OPT or use your OPT benefits, please notify your ISSS Advisor.
